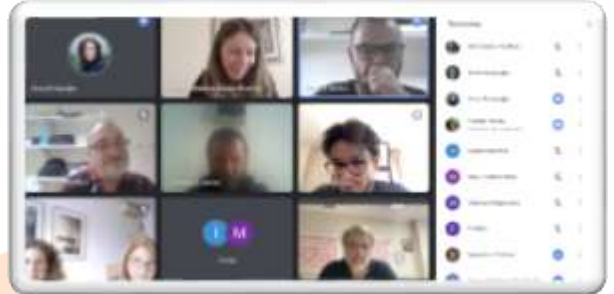
Both of these results will help to achieve a digital transformation model for the small craftsmen by providing them with a methodological training with multimedia learning content.
